



# Sharp HospiceCare Benefit Regatta

Saturday, August 28, 2010

## NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: **Cortez Racing Association**

Host Club: **Coronado Yacht Club**

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009 – 2012, including US Sailing Prescriptions. USCG “Navigation Rules, International-Inland”, Bylaws and Class Rules of PHRF Southern California and PHRF San Diego, the Entry Form, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and any amendments hereto will apply.
- 1.2. A sailing vessel does NOT have the right of way over any large ship in the channel. RRS 60.2, 63.1 and A5 are modified to add that the Race Committee (R/C) may disqualify a yacht infringing this instruction without a hearing.
- 1.3. The race will use a “pursuit” or “reverse handicap” start, with each boat receiving a starting time based on their current PHRF RL rating. Starting times for each boat will be available on line after noon Friday, August 27, 2010 in an addendum to the Sailing Instructions.

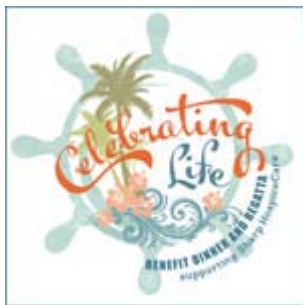
### 2. CLASSES AND RATINGS

- 2.1. PHRF San Diego Random Leg Ratings shall be used to score *all yachts*. These ratings will be as established by PHRF San Diego and/or the Race Committee.
- 2.2. Standard PHRF/CRA class breaks will be used. Entrants 20’ LOA or greater are eligible to register for ONE of the following:

Class 1	Spinnaker Random Leg Rating of +6 and below	#1
Class 2	Spinnaker Random Leg Rating of +9 through +69, with a performance factor of 3.0 and greater (sport boats) length	#2
Class 3	Spinnaker Random Leg Rating of +9 through +69, with a performance factor Less than 3.0; Random Leg Rating of +72 through +84; Random Leg Rating of +87 through +135 with LOA 42 feet or greater	#3
Class 4	Spinnaker Random Leg Rating of +87 through +135 with LOA less than 42 feet	#4
Class 5	Spinnaker Random Leg Rating of +138 and greater	#5
CRA Class 6	Non-Spinnaker All Ratings	#6
PHRF Class 6a	Non-Spinnaker RLC Ratings less than 177	Green
PHRF Class 6b	Non-Spinnaker RLC Ratings 177 and greater	Yellow
Physician’s Challenge	By invitation only	White

### 3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. To be eligible for fleet and class awards, a yacht must meet all Entry Eligibility requirements of the event. To be eligible, yachts must have a current Rating Certificate from PHRF San Diego, or submit a current PHRF Southern California Rating Certificate with their entry. Yachts that race with their PHRF Southern California Certificate will not have this race scored for the annual PHRF San Diego Championship Series
- 3.2. Eligible yachts shall be entered by submission of a completed [online entry form](#) and payment of the entry fee. Entry form and entry fee must be submitted to no later than NOON on Thursday, August 26, 2010.
- 3.3. Regatta Entry Fee: (Includes entry into regatta and specified number of post-race BBQ tickets which will be distributed on day of race in the skipper packets, additional BBQ tickets are available for \$10 with your on-line entry or at post race dinner):
  - Boats up to 29 feet in length: \$70.00 ( 6 BBQ tickets)
  - Boats 30 to 40 feet in length: \$95.00 ( 8 BBQ tickets)
  - Boats 41 feet and longer: \$120.00 (10 BBQ tickets)



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### 3.4. All Proceeds from the race entry fees will go to Sharp HospiceCare.

## 5. STARTING TIMES, AREA, and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The first warning will be at 1255.
- 5.2. The STARTING AREA will be in the area NW of Channel Buoy # 21, close to the center of Harbor Island (near the ½ mi. Range Markers across from Sheraton Harbor Island Hotel). For navigation, refer to NOAA CHART # 18733, San Diego Bay
- 5.3. The SAILING AREA will be the San Diego City Front.
- 5.4. The FINISH AREA will be in the vicinity of Channel Buoy # 26.
- 5.5. Sailing Instructions will also be available on the Cortez Racing Association website at [www.cortezracing.com](http://www.cortezracing.com).

## 6. SCORING

- 6.1. The Low Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 6.2. All Fleets will be scored in class and overall.
- 6.3. This race is part of the CRA Hi-Point series, and part of the PHRF-High-Point series for classes 1-5, 6a and 6b.

## 7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Trophies will be awarded to the first and second place boats scored in each PHRF Hi-Points class and to the third place boat scored in any PHRF Hi-Points class with 8 or more boats starting.
- 7.2. Sharp Hospice Care will award prizes to finishers in the Physicians Challenge.
- 7.3. First Overall Winner will be awarded a trophy and will be invited to participate on behalf of Sharp HospiceCare and CRA in the 2011 National Hospice Regatta Alliance.
- 7.4. To encourage wider participation and in addition to any applicable PHRF Hi-Points class scoring, boats in one design fleets racing in either one design or PHRF configuration will be awarded trophies for the first boat of the class to finish in any one design fleet which registers five or more paid entries.
- 7.5. Additional prizes may be awarded to competitors solely at the discretion of CRA and/or Sharp HospiceCare.



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### 8. SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- 8.1. Pre-Race Auction-Dinner-Dance. An Auction-Dinner-Dance to benefit Sharp HospiceCare will be held at the Hotel del Coronado starting at 5:30 PM on Friday, August 27, 2010. This is a separately ticketed event.
