<b>ANNUAL HI-POINTS CHAMPIONSHIP RULES</b>																											
1. To be eligible for Hi-Points Championship a boat must sail in 50% or more of the qualified CRA races.																											
2. All CRA races except the Beer Can Series will be scored for the Hi-Point Championship for each year beginning with the Year-End Regatta and ending with the Fall Regatta.																											
3. Only scores for boats that start races (or serve as Race Committee boat) will be included in the Hi-Point total. DNC and DNS will not provide points.																											
4. Each boat that starts a race shall receive one point even if they are scored with an OCS, BFD, DNF, RAF, DSQ, DNE or DGM.																											
5. Boats shall receive Hi-Points scores based upon the number of boats that start each race properly.																											
6. The first place boat shall receive one point for starting plus points equal to the number of boats that start. The second place boat shall receive one point for starting plus points equal to the number of starters less one and so on.																											
7. The three lowest scores, including scores of no points, will be throw-outs.																											
8. Ties will be broken by the results from the most recent race in which either boat sailed.																											
<b>PROVISIONS FOR RACE COMMITTEE DUTY BOAT</b>																											
1. The boat will be awarded either its average finish position, (rounded to the better score) in her two prior races:																											
2. Or, she will be awarded a third place finish for the first race for which she serves as RC and a second place finish for any subsequent race.
