NOTICE OF RACE **ULLMAN SAILS** HALLOWEEN REGATTA

1 **RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of* Sailing, including US Sailing Prescriptions, except US Sailing Prescriptions to Rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply. Sections B and D of Appendix T will apply.
- 1.2 The USCG "Navigation Rules, International-Inland" (www.navcen.uscg.gov/) apply when a boat sailing under the Racing Rules of Sailing meets a vessel that is not.
- 1.3 Class Rules of PHRF Southern California (www.phrfsandiego.org) will apply to Classes #1-6. However, Rule 8 (MIR rule) of the PHRF class rules will not apply.
- 1.4 Rules of any other class entered as a class will apply to that class.
- 1.5 RRS 55 will be changed in the sailing instructions by adding the following sentence to the rule: 'However, discarding biodegradable bands when setting a sail is permitted.'

2 **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all members of organizations affiliated with US Sailing.
- 2.2 All eligible boats must enter on-line at www.cortezracing.com, no later than 6:00pm on Friday, Oct. 28, 2016.
- 2.3 Late entries will only be accepted from CRA members. Late entrants may not check in by radio, but must provide to the R/C, in writing, the owner's name, DOB and zip code, boat name and type, sail number, class, and RLC rating.

3 FEES

\$40 Registration fee for non-CRA members, with a \$5 discount for USSA membership. No charge for CRA members.

CLASSES, CLASS PENNANTS, AND PENNANT COLOR 4

4.1 The class numeral pennant must be flown from the backstay of all yachts when checking in, while racing, and when finishing.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 *Two* races are scheduled.
- 5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is **11:55am**. The warning signal for the second race will be as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.
- 5.3 No warning signal for a race will be made after **4:00pm**.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The starting area is in the vicinity of the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile marker mid-Harbor Island.
- 7.2 The racing area covers the general locale known as San Diego Bay. For navigation, refer to NOAA Chart #18773, San Diego Bay.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 Penalties While Racing:

For all classes, the first two sentences of Rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing or rule 31. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 9.3 Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores. No score will be excluded.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile devices.
