Add to the US Sailing Nearshore SERs for the Commodore's Cup: Items 2.4.1 2.4.8 from the <u>US Sailing Coastal SERs</u> are included and apply to all boats whose factory configurations include lifelines, stanchions, pulpits, and toe rails with the following modification: SER 2.4.4 Lifelines may have factory installed coating. The Nearshore SERs do not include the requirement for lifelines, which I (Colleen) believe are an important safety item for those boats designed to have lifelines, when sailing in ocean swells.

Motion – Coastal SERs are recommended and Near Shore SERs are required and Life Lines as listed above are required for DC Around the Coronados – vote: YES unanimous

Motion - to require crotch straps on life jackets beginning in 2025 for the DC Around the Coronados – Vote: YES unanimous

This applies only to boats sailed sequentially, not going back and forth from boat to boat but only boat after boat. The member need not be onboard to be scored. vote: YES unanimous make this retroactive for all 2024 High Point Regattas/races vote: YES unanimous
